Title:	Apply finishing procedures in a clothing production environment

Purpose

This unit standard specifies the competencies required to apply finishing procedures in a clothing production environment. It includes preparing the work station, finishing of work and dispatching assembled garments. This unit standard is intended for people who work in the clothing production industry.

Special Notes

1. Entry information:
Prerequisite
 - Unit 130 - *Follow workplace safety procedures in a clothing production environment* or demonstrated equivalent knowledge and skills.
2. To demonstrate competence, at a minimum, evidence is required of preparing the workstation, finishing of work and dispatching assembled garments.
3. Assessment evidence may be collected from a real workplace or a simulated real workplace or an appropriate simulated realistic environment in which clothing production operations are carried out.
4. Tools, equipment and material may include but are not limited to components and garments, tailor's dummy, thread cutter, tweezers, packaging materials, rails, hangers, store rooms, shelving and cupboards.
5. Garments may include but are not limited pencil skirts, A-line skirts, gathered skirts, pleated skirts, gored skirts and sleeveless blouses.
6. Performance of all elements in this unit standard must comply with all relevant workplace requirements and /or manufacturer's specifications.
7. Regulations and legislation relevant to this unit standard include the following:
 - Labour Act, No. 6, 1992
 - Occupational Health and Safety Regulations No. 18, 1997
 and all subsequent amendments.

Elements and Performance Criteria

Element 1: Prepare work station

Performance Criteria

- 1.1 Workstation is set up in line with workplace specifications.
- 1.2 Components or garments are laid out correctly in line with workplace specifications.

Element 2: Finish work

Performance Criteria

- 2.1 Finishing is performed according to customer and workplace specifications.
- 2.2 Garment or article is checked for correct sizing, loose threads, missing buttons and attachments.
- 2.3 Boxing, packing, bagging, folding and hanging are performed in line with workplace specifications.
- 2.4 Faults are reported, rectified and recorded according to workplace specifications.

Element 3: Dispatch assembled garments

Performance Criteria

- 3.1 Completed garments or articles are transferred to respective section in line with workplace specifications.
- 3.2 Work area is cleaned up and prepared for next job or operation.
