

The Namibian Training Authority (NTA) endeavours to become Namibia's port of call of vocational skills through the sustainable facilitation of training related services provision, organisational effectiveness, funding, regulation, the administration of the Vocational Education and training (VET) levy, and stakeholder engagement and satisfaction.

The NTA has initiated a review of the current approach to Competency-Based Education and Training (CBET) with a view to developing a system that meets the needs of industry, trainees and the community. Under CBET industry developed unit standards provide the basis for the design of training programmes, assessment and national qualifications.

TEN (Pty) Ltd has been commissioned by the NTA to conduct the review of the CBET system.
