The Namibia Training Authority (NTA) develops and reviews national Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) qualifications for registration on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF). It is against this background that the NTA invites qualified candidates with experience in the following occupational areas to serve as Technical Working Group (TWG) / Subject Matter Expert members, and to review/develop the Unit Standards and Qualifications currently registered on the NQF:
