### NAMIBIA TRAINING AUTHORITY INTERIM POSITION ON UNVERIFIED ALLEGATIONS CONTAINED IN ANONYMOUS PETITION

The Namibia Training Authority (NTA) is aware of unverified allegations contained in an unsigned petition addressed to the Minister of Education, Innovation, Youth, Sports, Arts and Culture, circulated by an anonymous source on social media platforms, and on which some local media houses have reported.

The NTA does not typically comment on rumours. However, in considering the petition's malicious department, we have embarked on an immediate internal review and assessment of the serious allegations it contains.

While this process is ongoing, we will not be commenting on this matter. We will take appropriate action based on the findings of this review and will provide updates as necessary.

The NTA maintains and remains committed to the highest standards of corporate governance and transparency in all our business dealings, in line with Namibia's legal and regulatory frameworks.
